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Cabinet Vision Keyboard Shortcuts

The most powerful shortcut/tool in Cabinet Vision!

Copy = Ctrl+C Paste = Ctrl+V Cut = Ctrl+X

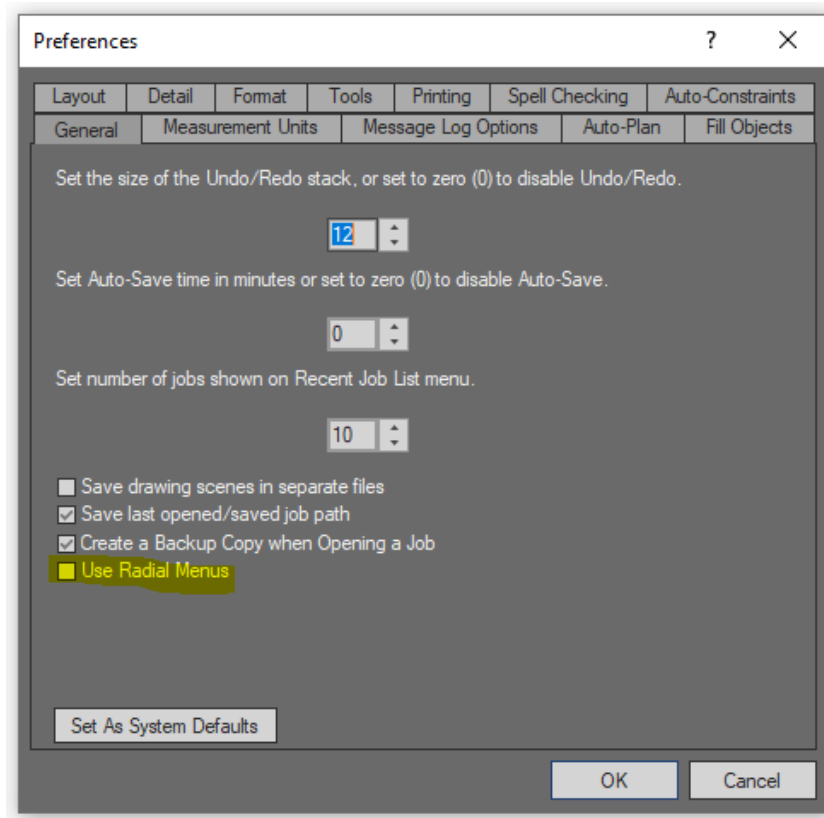
I know these are not new shortcuts because they are used universally across most programs but there might be some applications of it that you might not have thought of.

- **Copy/Cut a single or a group of cabinets** from one room to another from the plan view or elevation. Note, they have to be on the same wall face.
- **Copy/Cut CAD from a drawing scene into model space**, this works great for putting sections or details into the model space.
- **Copy/Cut CAD into CAM space when adding operations to a part**, this can be helpful when there are complicated layouts needed.

These are only a couple of the applications for this. Keep an open mind and if you can select the item or CAD then you can more than likely copy and paste it!

Keyboard Shortcuts:

These shortcuts below **apply only when the radial menu is turned off** or on versions 11 and below.





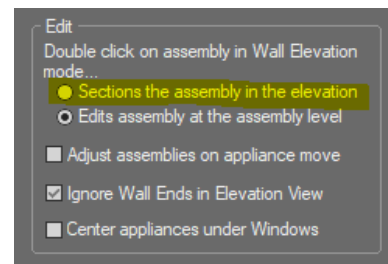
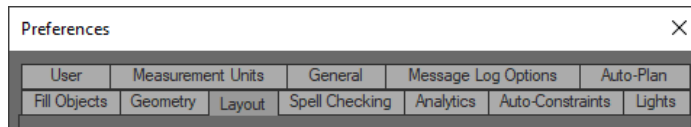
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Having your left hand resting on the keyboard on the standard asdf keys allows you to have these shortcuts in quick access.

Shortcuts In model space:

- **Delete assembly:** Right click on assembly type “d”
(you can select a cabinet and then use delete key as well but this way keeps your left hand in the same position on the keyboard “asdf”)
- **Delete groups of assemblies:** highlight multiple assemblies by using a selection box around all of them or you can select multiple assemblies by left clicking while holding Ctrl. Once the cabinets are selected, right click on any of the assemblies and then select delete.
- **Rehinge single door assembly:** Right click on assembly type “r”
This also works for assemblies that have multiple single doors vertically.
- **Send to drawing:** Right click and type “t”, this works in the plan or elevation view
- **Send to live drawing:** Right click and type “v”, this works in the plan or elevation view
- **Hide wall for 3D view:** in the plan view right click on wall and type “h”
- **Section cabinet in elevation:** hold Alt and double click assembly.
Once this is activated then you can double click on another assembly to section it in the elevation. This only applies when the option is turned off in the preferences.



Shortcuts In the drawing pages:

- **Delete:** Right click and type “d”
- **Clean Sheet:** Right click and type “c”
- **Scale:** Right click and type “s”, this works for the page scale as well as the scene scale
- **Title Block:** Right click and type “t”
